- **A.** Wildlife Feeding Restrictions Deer and Similar Animals: Members reviewed the ordinance possibilities. A discussion was held about the penalty and the desire to have stepped warnings, as well as clear exceptions. A motion was made to table the item and request the Administrator to recommend a list of exceptions, and penalty tiers by Member Levine and seconded by Member Seiler. Motion carried all in favor.
- **B.** Consider SolSmart Certification: Member Pearson shared that this helps communities be solar friendly, is a free service and has some grant eligibility opportunities. Member Pearson made a motion

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to endorse the certification and refer it to Public Utility Commission for review and consideration. Member Levine seconded the motion. Motion carried all in favor.
