

## **Sylvan Park Campground & Riverview Campground City Campground Rules**

### **General Campground Rules**

#### **1. Fees**

- a. Fees are due upon arrival. No refunds will be issued due to weather, work obligations, or other circumstances.
- b. Campers must be at least 18 years old to rent a campsite.

#### **2. Check-In & Check-Out**

- a. Check-in begins daily at 12:00 p.m.
- b. Check-out is 11:00 a.m.

#### **3. Speed Limit & Parking**

- a. A 10 MPH speed limit must be followed at all times.
- b. Personal golf carts are permitted but must be registered with the City of Lanesboro. ATVs, UTVs, and motorbikes are not allowed.

#### **4. Quiet Hours**

- a. Quiet hours are from 11:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m.
- b. No loud music, excessive noise, or disorderly conduct is tolerated.

#### **5. Campground Cleanliness**

- a. Campers must dispose of all trash properly in the dumpsters provided.
- b. Fire pits should only be used for burning wood or charcoal—no trash or garbage. Fire pits should not be moved and must be fully extinguished before leaving.

#### **6. Firewood and Fireworks**

- a. Only certified, safe-to-burn firewood purchased within the City of Lanesboro is allowed. Pallet wood and treated lumber are prohibited.
- b. Fireworks, firecrackers, and any explosives are strictly prohibited.

#### **7. Pets**

- a. Pets must be leashed or tethered at all times.
- b. Pets should not be left unattended.
- c. Campers must clean up after their pets and dispose of waste properly.

#### **8. Theft & Liability**

- a. Campers are responsible for securing their personal property, including campers, vehicles, tents, and personal items.
- b. The City of Lanesboro is not responsible for theft, loss, or damage to personal property.
- c. Campers should maintain insurance on their vehicles, campers, and personal property.

#### **9. Reservation Cancellation Policy**

- a. Reservations require 25% deposit of the rental total.
- b. Reservations canceled seven days or more in advance of the booking will be charged a \$10.00 cancellation fee.
- c. Reservations canceled less than seven days in advance of the booking will be charged a cancellation fee of 25% of the rental total.

## **RV Site Rules**

### **1. Parking**

- a. Only one vehicle is allowed to park on an RV site. Additional vehicles must park in designated areas.
- b. No awning-to-awning parking is allowed.

### **2. Hookups & Site Use**

- a. Campers must properly use all electrical, water, and sewer hookups.
- b. Gray water and black water must be disposed of properly—dumping on the ground is strictly prohibited.
- c. Campers must keep their sites clean and free of excessive clutter.

### **3. Site Stay Limits**

- a. Campers may occupy a specific RV site for a maximum of 14 consecutive nights.
- b. After 14 consecutive nights, campers must vacate the campground for at least 48 hours before returning, or they must relocate to a different site if available, with a maximum total stay of 28 nights in any 60-day period.<sup>i</sup>

## **Tent Site Rules**

### **1. Parking**

- a. No driving or parking on tent sites is allowed. Vehicles must be parked in designated areas.

### **2. Site Use**

- a. Only tents and small camping equipment are allowed—no RVs, trailers, or large structures.
- b. Open flames must be confined to designated fire pits.

## **Enforcement**

### **1. Failure to Comply**

- a. Violation of the city campground rules will result in being asked to leave and campers may be prohibited from returning for the remainder of the season.

<sup>i</sup> **Extended Stay Permit (by request only):** Campers may request an extended stay permit from the City for up to an additional 14 nights, subject to availability and at the discretion of campground management. Extended stays are not guaranteed and will not be issued during high-demand periods or special event
